Issue

A new version has been released

Version 6 of ESET Remote Administrator (ERA) and ESET business products were released in North America December 11th, 2014, and globally February 25th, 2015. When performing a push installation to more than 20 computers, additional machines are placed into a queue Use ESET Remote Administrator (ERA) to push install to more than 20 client workstations

NOTE:

By default, ERA will only perform up to 20 concurrent push installations at a time. Any additional push installations will be placed into a queue until a thread becomes available.

Solution

Although it is not recommended (for potential performance reasons), you can increase the maximum number of concurrent push installations

to more than the default value of 20. To change this value in ESET Remote Administrator Console (ERAC), follow the steps below:

- Open the ESET Remote Administrator Console (ERAC) by clicking Start → All Programs → ESET → ESET Remote Administrator Console → ESET Remote Administrator Console.
- 2. Click **Tools** → **Server Options**.

3. Click the **Advanced** tab → **Edit Advanced Settings**.

- Expand Remote Administrator → ERA
 Server → Settings → Remote Install and select Maximum number of concurrent push installation threads.
- 5. Type your desired value into the **Value** field and then click **Console** to save your changes. When prompted to confirm, click **Yes**.

- 6. Click **OK** to exit the **Server Options** window.
- 7. Restart the **ESET Remote Administrator server** service.
- 8. After restarting the ESET Remote Administrator Server service, you need to reconnect ERAC by clicking **File** → **Connect** in the main program window.
