Version 6 of ESET Remote Administrator (ERA) and ESET business products were released in North America December 11th, 2014, and globally February 25th, 2015. Enable pre-release updates using ESET Remote Administrator

1. Open the ESET Configuration Editor by clicking **Start → All**

**Programs → ESET → ESET Remote Administrator
Console → ESET Configuration Editor.**

1. Expand **Windows product line v3 and v4 → Update module → Profile → Settings** and then click **Pre-release updates**.

1. Select the check box next to **Value**.

1. Open ESET Smart Security Business Edition or ESET NOD32 Antivirus Business Edition. [How do I open my ESET product?](#)
2. Press the F5 key to open **Advanced setup**.
3. Click **Update** and then click **Setup**.
