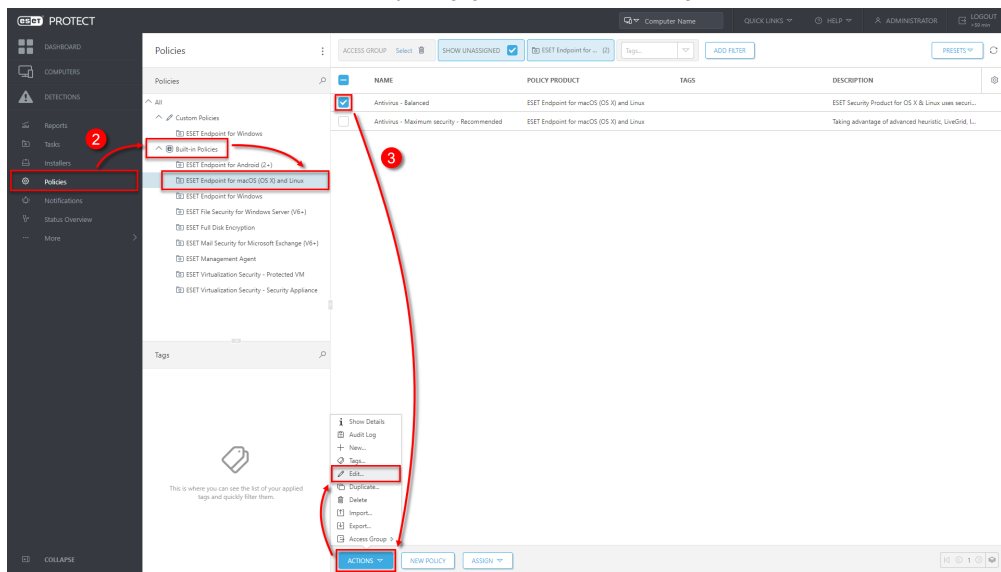

### Issue

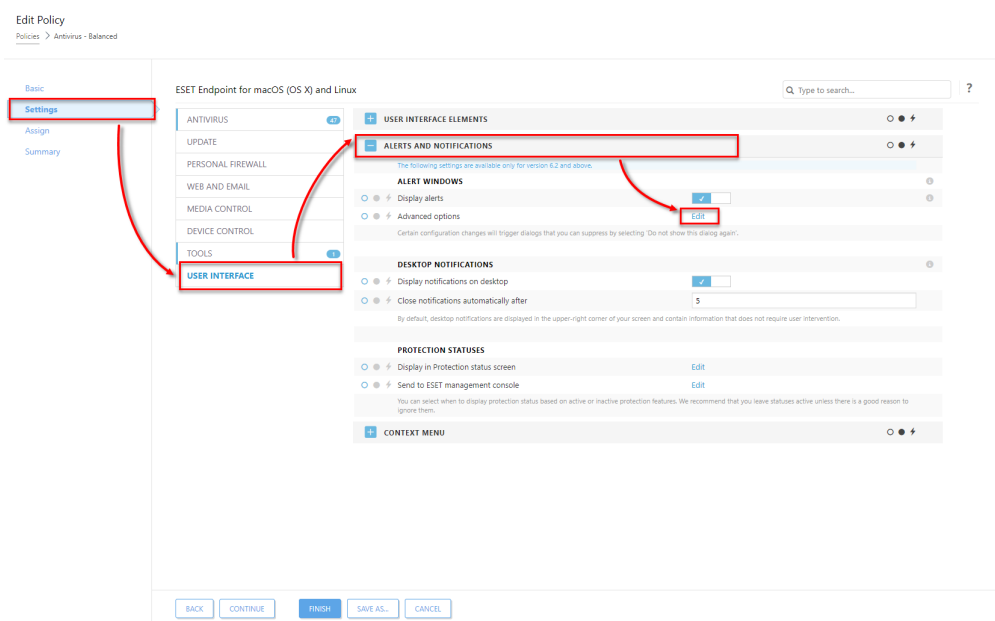
- Your ESET product notifies you with a yellow or red icon  and displays the notification "Operating system is not up to date"

### Solution

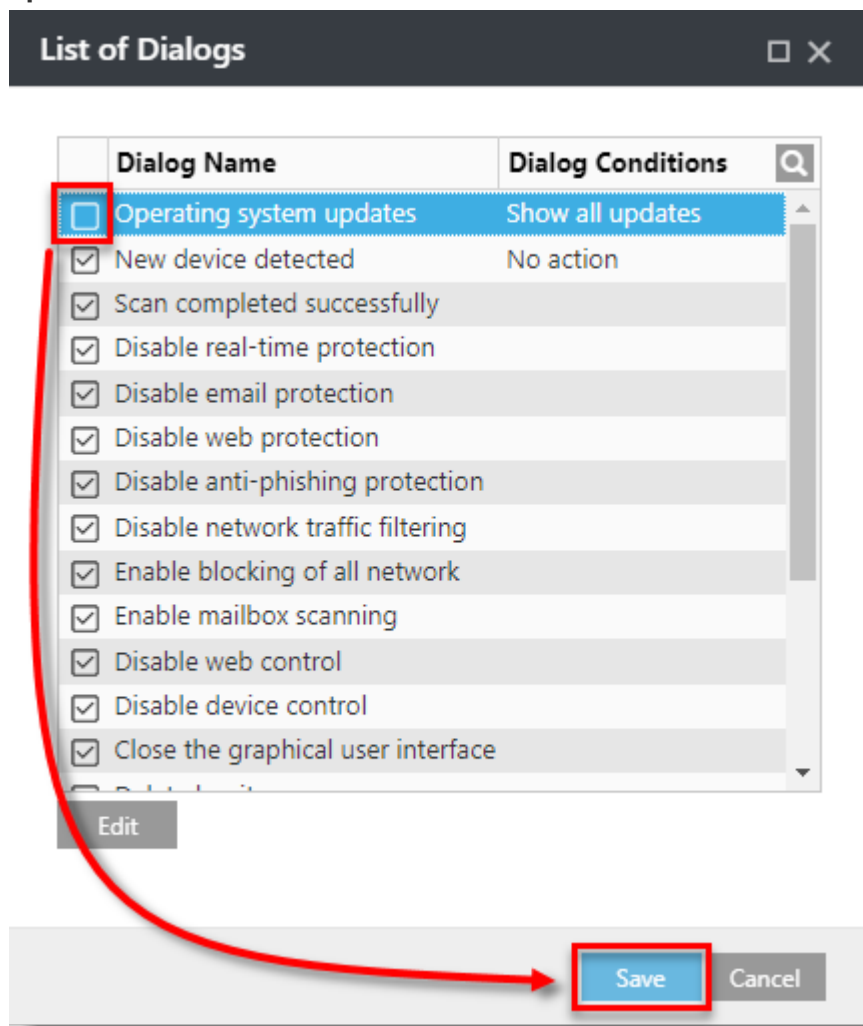
1. [Open the ESET PROTECT Web Console](#) in your web browser and log in.
2. Click **Policies**, expand **Built-in Policies** and click **ESET Endpoint for macOS (OS X) and Linux**.
3. Select the check box next to the policy you want to modify and click **Actions** → **Edit**.



4. Click **Settings** → **User interface**, expand **Alerts and notifications** and next to **Advanced options**, click **Edit**.

#### ALERTS AND NOTIFICATIONS

The following settings are available only for version 6.2 and above.

##### ALERT WINDOWS

- Display alerts
- Advanced options

Certain configuration changes will trigger dialogs that you can suppress by selecting "Do not show this dialog again".

##### DESKTOP NOTIFICATIONS

- Display notifications on desktop
- Close notifications automatically after: 5

By default, desktop notifications are displayed in the upper-right corner of your screen and contain information that does not require user intervention.

##### PROTECTION STATUSES

- Display in Protection status screen
- Send to ESET management console

You can select when to display protection status based on active or inactive protection features. We recommend that you leave statuses active unless there is a good reason to ignore them.
