If you need to change the Port number being used by your Enterprise Server, then please follow these steps:

Step 1.

On the host machine where your Enterprise Server is installed, navigate to:

On 64-bit machines: C:\Program Files (x86)\DESlock+ HTTP\conf\

On 32-bit machines: C:\Program Files\DESlock+ HTTP\conf\



Step 2.

In this directory, open 'httpd.txt' with Notepad and search the document for **Listen 80**.

Note: 80 is the default Port number used by the Enterprise Server.



Step 3.

Change **Listen 80** to the Port number you wish to use. i.e. Listen 90

Then save and close the document.



Step 4.

Hold **Win + R** to open the Run dialog. Type **services.msc** and click **OK**



Step 5.

In the list of Services, locate **DESlockHTTP** and then right-click it. Select **Restart** from the menu to restart the Service.



This will restart the service with the new Port number specified. You do not need to change anything further on the Enterprise Server or DESlock+ client machines.
