[Perform these steps on individual client workstations.](#)

Enable / disable device control Using Policy Manager

1. Open the ESET Remote Administrator Console by clicking **Start → All Programs → ESET → ESET Remote Administrator Console → ESET Remote Administrator Console**.

1. Click **Tools → ESET Policy Manager**. Click your default policy to select it and then click **Edit**.

3. Expand **Windows desktop v5 → Device management → Settings**.

3. Click **System integration: Yes**, leave the check box next to **Yes/No** selected if you want to use Device control, or deselect the check box next to **Yes/No** to disable Device control on client workstations.

3. Click **Console → Yes** to save your changes.

Enable / disable Device control on individual client workstations

1. Open the main program window by double-clicking the

ESET icon  in your Windows notification area or by clicking **Start → All Programs → ESET → ESET Endpoint Security** or **ESET Endpoint Antivirus**.

1. Press the **F5** key on your keyboard to access the Advanced setup window.

1. Expand **Computer**, click **Device control** and then select the check box next to **Integrate into system**. Click **OK** to save your changes.
