Solution

The ESET Remote Administrator Web Console (ERA Web Console) is accessed using most web browsers ([view compatible web browsers](#)):

On your local ERA Server: Open your ERA-compatible web browser and enter **<https://localhost/era>** into the address bar to access the ERA Web Console.

From an outside computer: If your ESET Remote Administrator Server (ERA Server) is accessible to outside connections, you can access the ERA Web Console from nearly anywhere. Open your web browser and enter **<https://%yourservername%/era>** (replace %yourservername% with the actual IP address or name of your web server, for example **<https://10.1.30.30/era>**) into the address bar to access the ERA Web Console.

Which port does ERA Console use?

By default, ERA Web Console uses port 443. In some cases when port 443 is not available, port 8443 is used. [How do I change the port used by ESET Remote Administrator Web Console?](#)
