### Scan client workstations using ESET Remote Administrator

1. Open the ESET Remote Administrator Console by clicking **Start** → **All Programs** → **ESET** → **ESET Remote Administrator Console** → **ESET Remote Administrator Console**.
1. Select the client workstations you want to scan, right-click, and click **New Task** → **On-Demand Scan**.

2. Configure your scan in the **On-Demand Scan** window and click **Next** (in this example, the scan will run using the default settings).

3. In the **Select Clients** window, make sure the correct client workstations are selected and click **Next**.

## Scan individual client workstations

Click **Tools → Log files**.

Select **Computer scan** from the **Log** drop-down menu. Double-click the line representing the most recently completed scan. A new **Computer scan** window will appear and display the scan log details.
