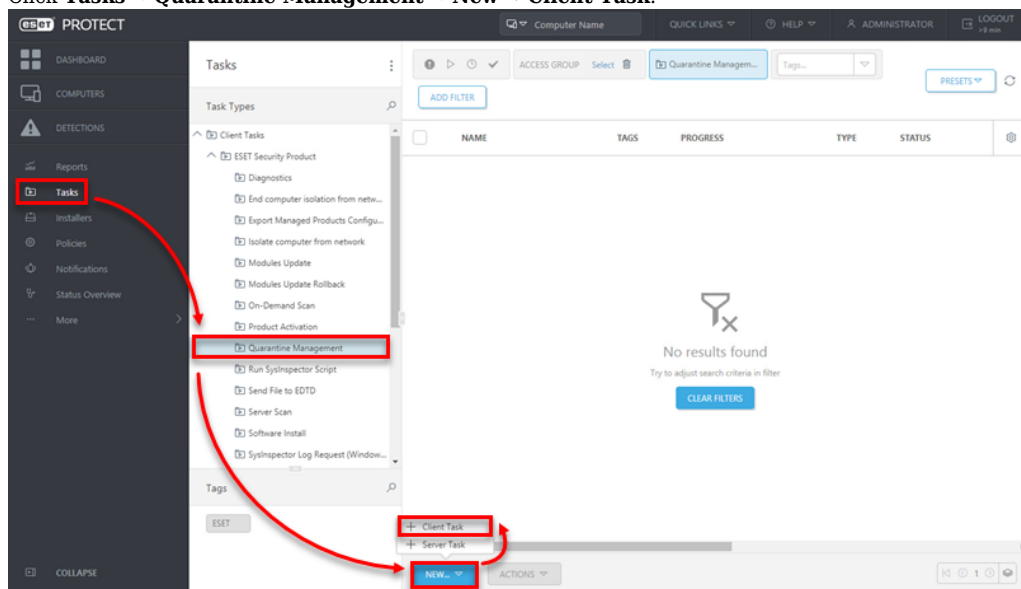

Solution

Create a Quarantine Management task

1. [Open ESET PROTECT Web Console](#) in your web browser and log in.
2. Click **Tasks** → **Quarantine Management** → **New** → **Client Task**.



3. Type a name into the **Name** field and click **Settings**.

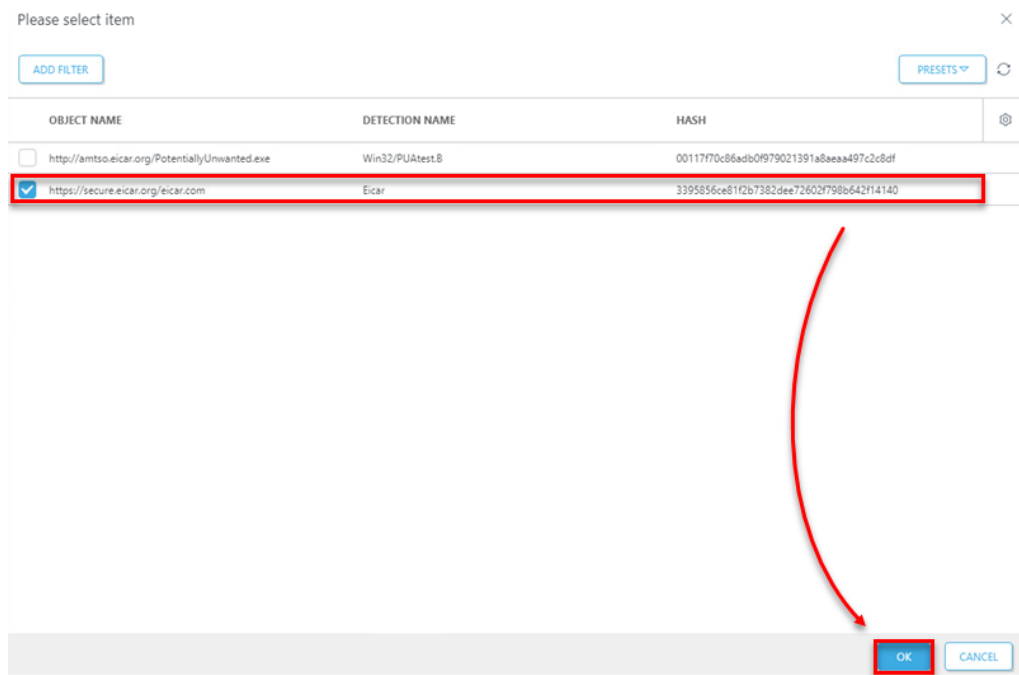

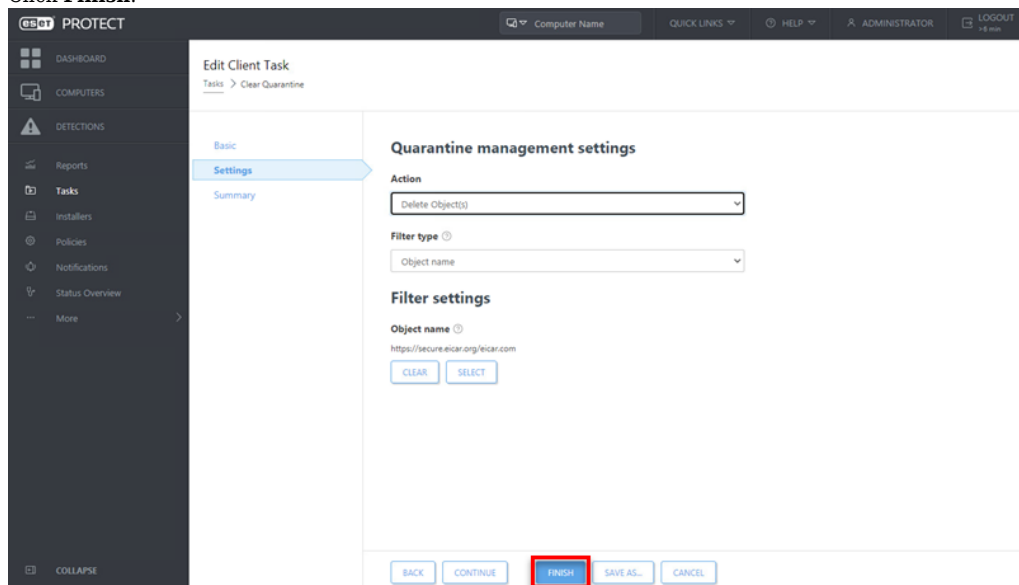

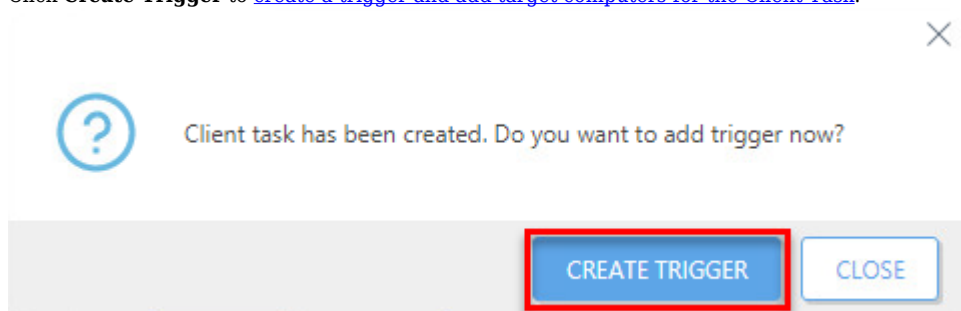
5. Select the object from the list of quarantined files and click **OK**.



6. Click **Finish**.

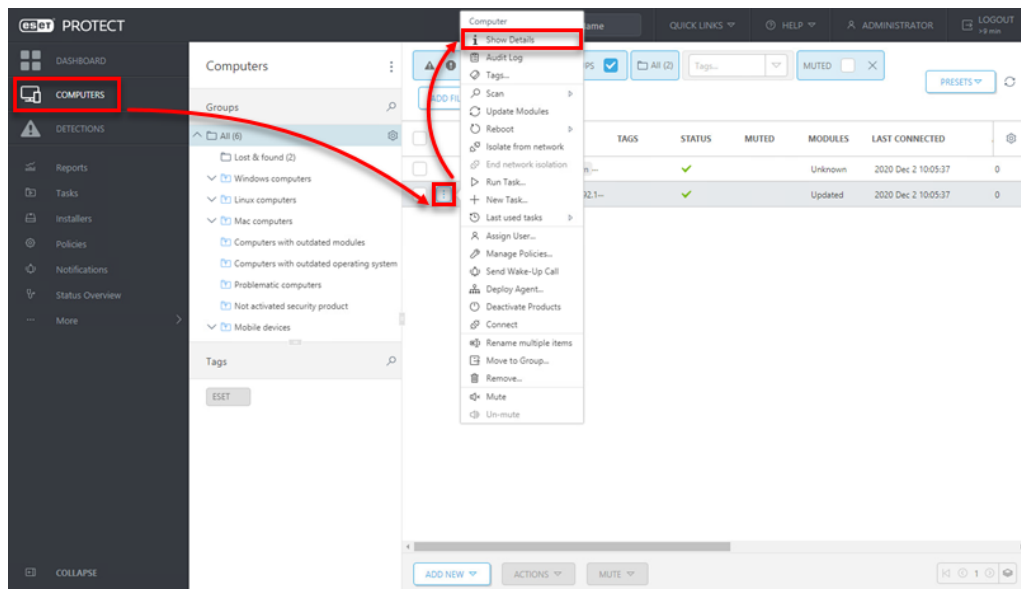


7. Click **Create Trigger** to [create a trigger and add target computers for the Client Task](#).



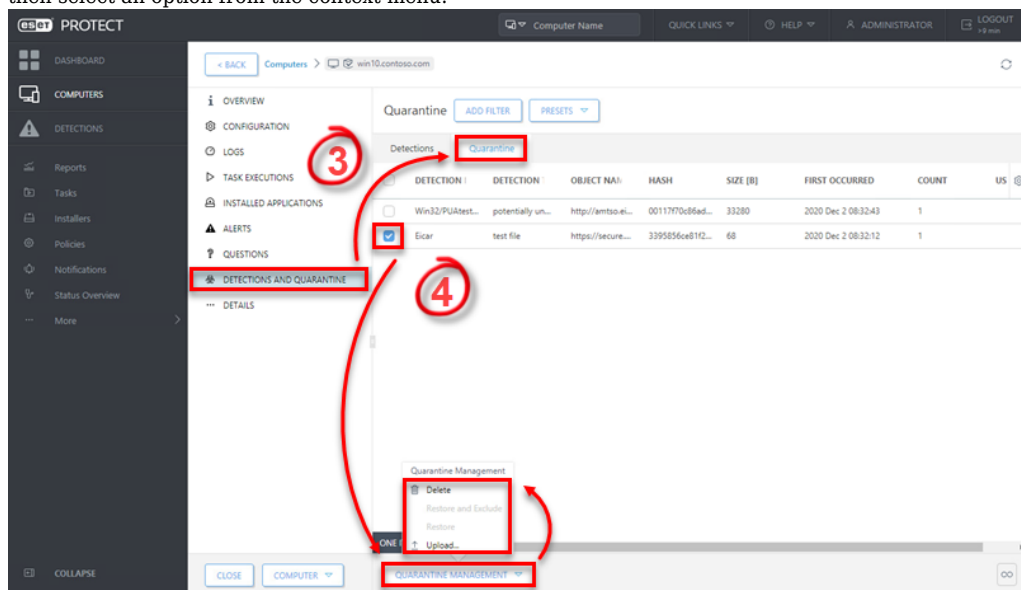
Manage quarantine on an individual client workstation

1. [Open ESET PROTECT Web Console](#) in your web browser and log in.
2. Click **Computers**, click the computer you want to manage, and then select **Show Details**.



3. Click **Detections and Quarantine – Quarantine**.

4. Select the check box next to each object you want to manage, click **Quarantine Management**, and then select an option from the context menu.



5. You will see a popup that the task has been scheduled.
