

## Missing libQtWebKit dependency on CentOS Linux

### Issue

---

libQtWebKit package is not available on CentOS Linux operating system

Reports cannot be generated from ERA Web Console

The following error message is displayed in log files:

```
Error: CReportPrinterModule [Thread 7f5f4c7b8700]:  
ReportPrinter: ReportPrinterTool exited with:  
/opt/eset/RemoteAdministrator/Server//ReportPrinterTool:  
error while loading shared libraries:  
libQtWebKit.so.4: cannot open shared object file:  
No such file or directory [code:127]
```

### Solution

---

Qt4 WebKit libraries are required - Used for printing reports to PDF and PS format (must be version 4.x, not 5).

#### Important!

Check to see if the problem is resolved after each step. If not, proceed to the next step until the problem is resolved.

1. Run the following command in Terminal (as root or with sudo) to install libQtWebKit directly from Fedora repositories.

64-bit operating systems:

```
yum install
```

```
https://dl.fedoraproject.org/pub/epel/7/x86_64/q/q  
twebkit-2.3.4-6.el7.x86_64.rpm
```

32-bit operating systems:

```
yum install
```

```
https://dl.fedoraproject.org/pub/epel/6/i386/qtweb  
kit-2.1.1-1.el6.i686.rpm
```

2. Verify the presence of remaining [ERA Server prerequisites](#). All mandatory prerequisites must be met.
3. Compile and install the libQtWebKit source package using the following instructions (Advanced Linux users only):
