Issue

ESET program settings are not password-protected on client workstations

Solution

Version 6.1.2227 and later only

The steps below will only work on ESET Remote Administrator and ESET Endpoint Antivirus / ESET Endpoint Security version 6.1.2227 and later (and ESET File Security for Microsoft Windows Server 6.2.x and later).
