Solution

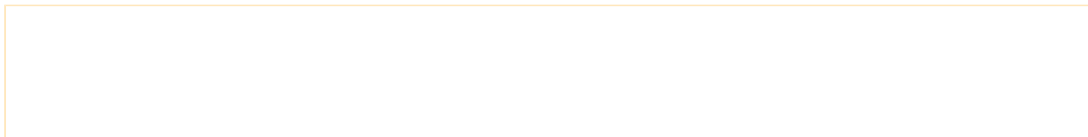
Version 6.1.2227 and later only
