In situations where you do not want to, or cannot use a [push uninstall](#) to remove an ESET endpoint or server solution, follow the steps below to uninstall on an individual client or server workstation.

A restart may be required

If you are performing these steps on a server, we recommend that you plan a maintenance window to allow for a restart after removing your ESET product.

1. Press the **Windows key**  + **R** to open a **Run** dialog.
2. Type **Appwiz.cpl** into the field and click **OK**.
3. In the **Uninstall or Change a program** window, select the ESET product you want to remove and click **Change**.

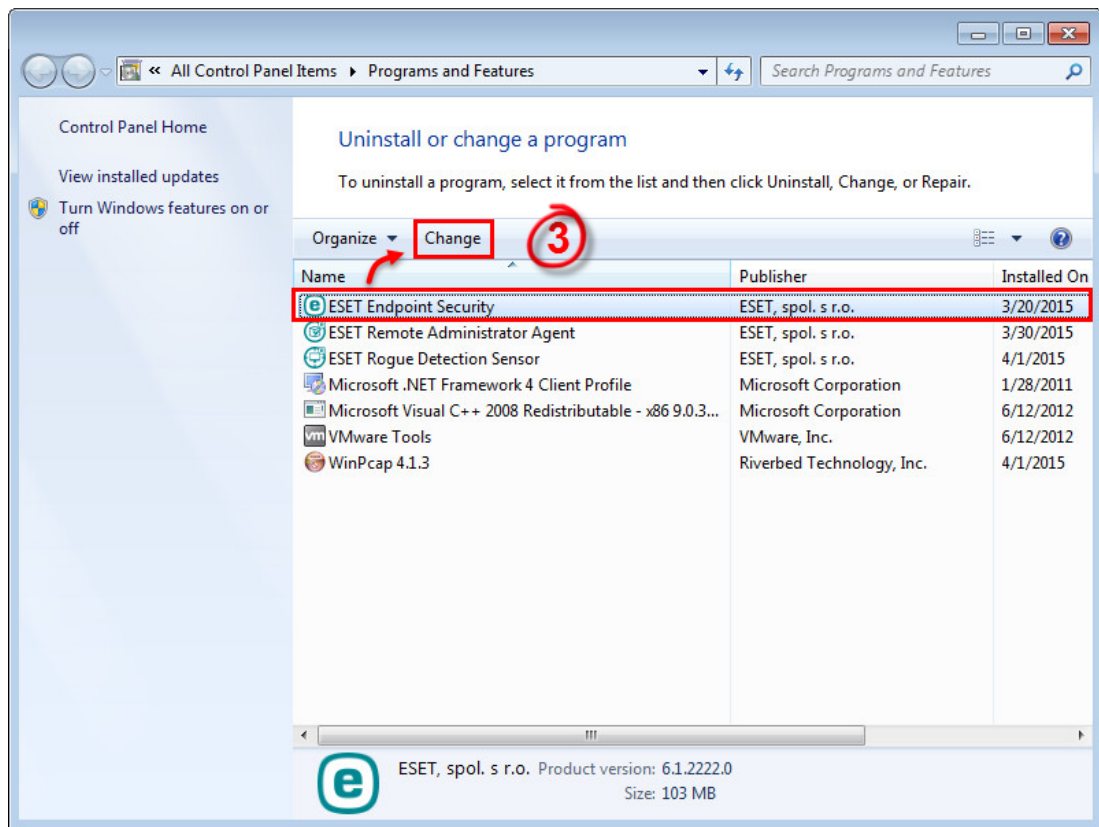

1. Click **Next**.

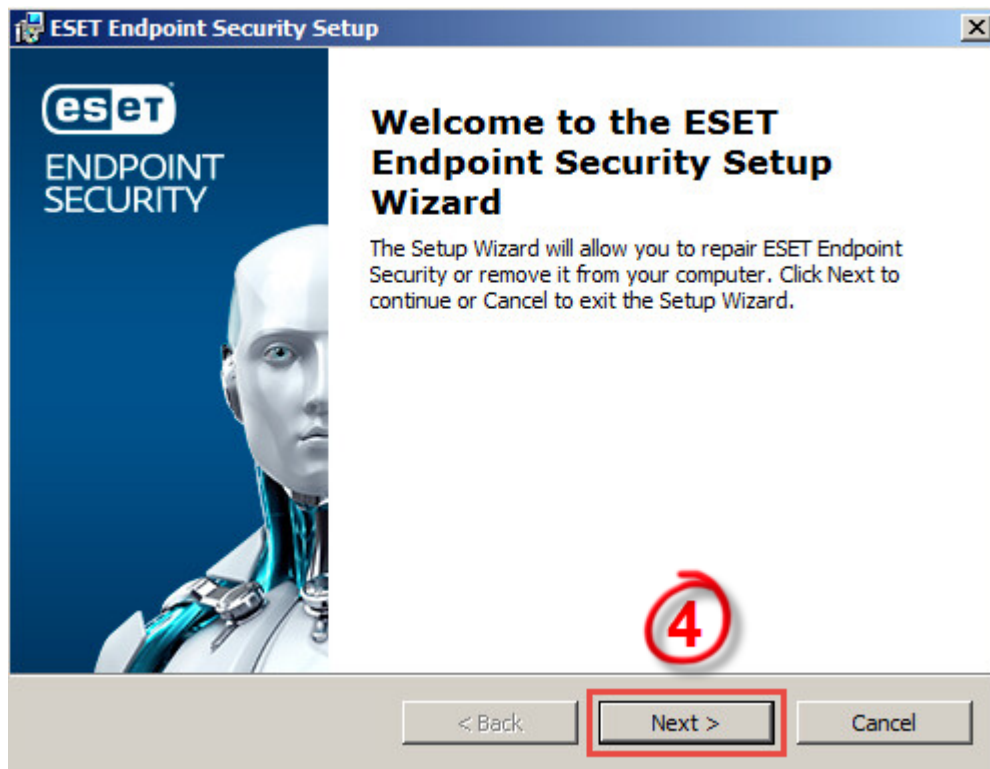

1. Click **Remove**.

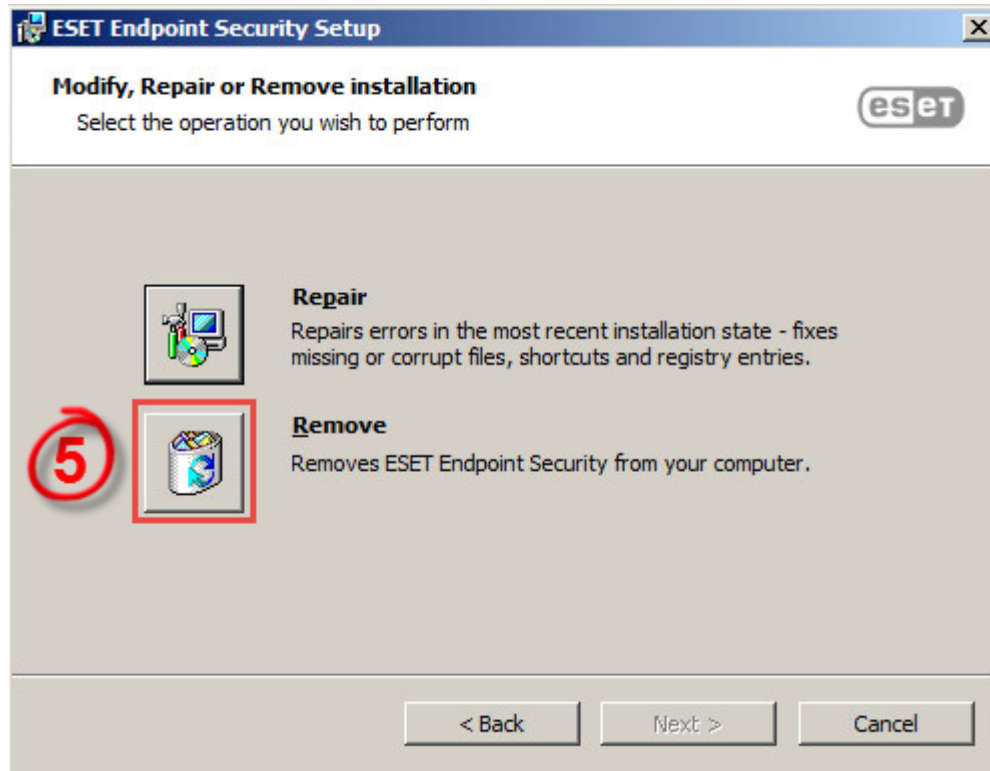

1. Select a reason for uninstalling and click **Next**.

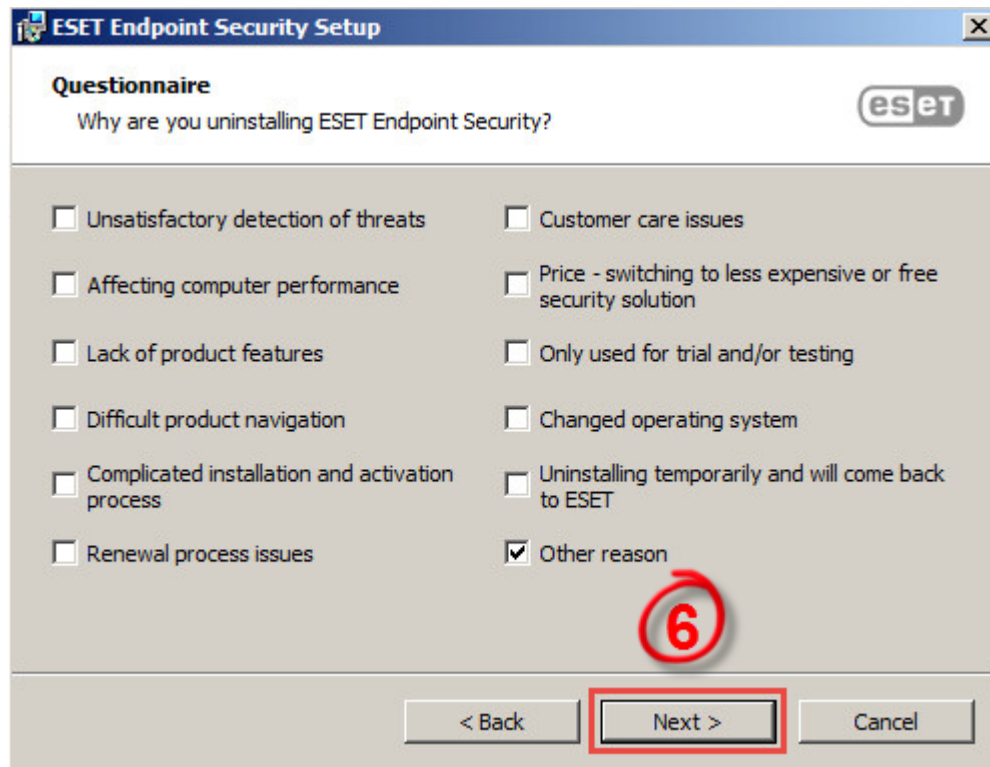

1. Click **Remove**.

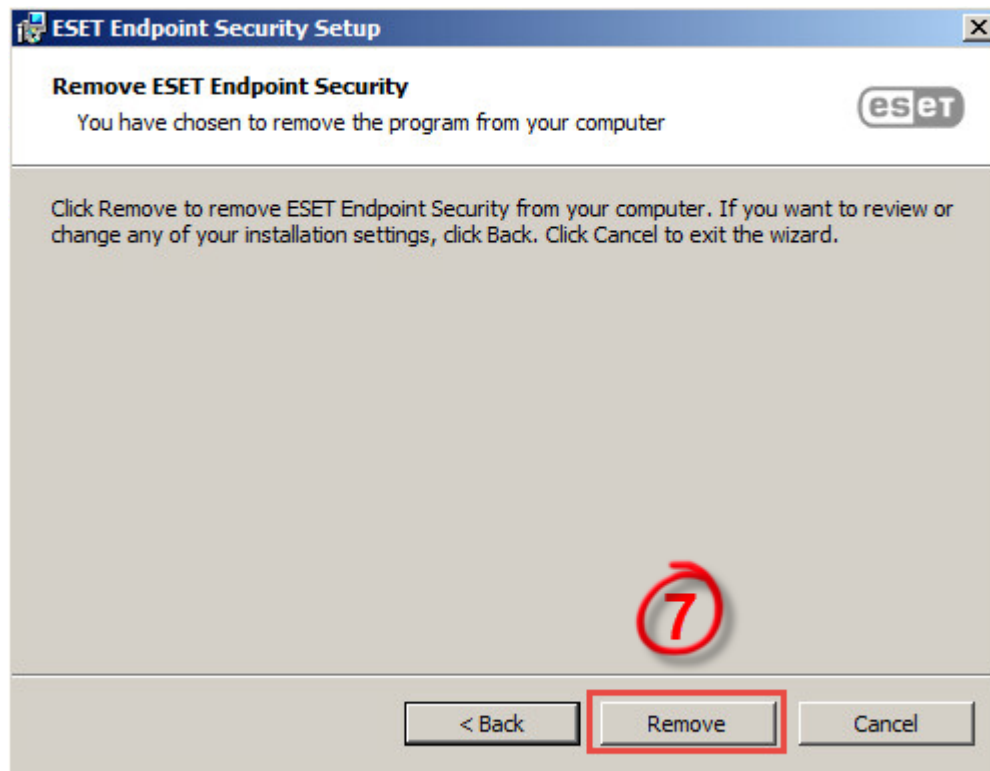

1. Click **Finish**. Your ESET product has been uninstalled.

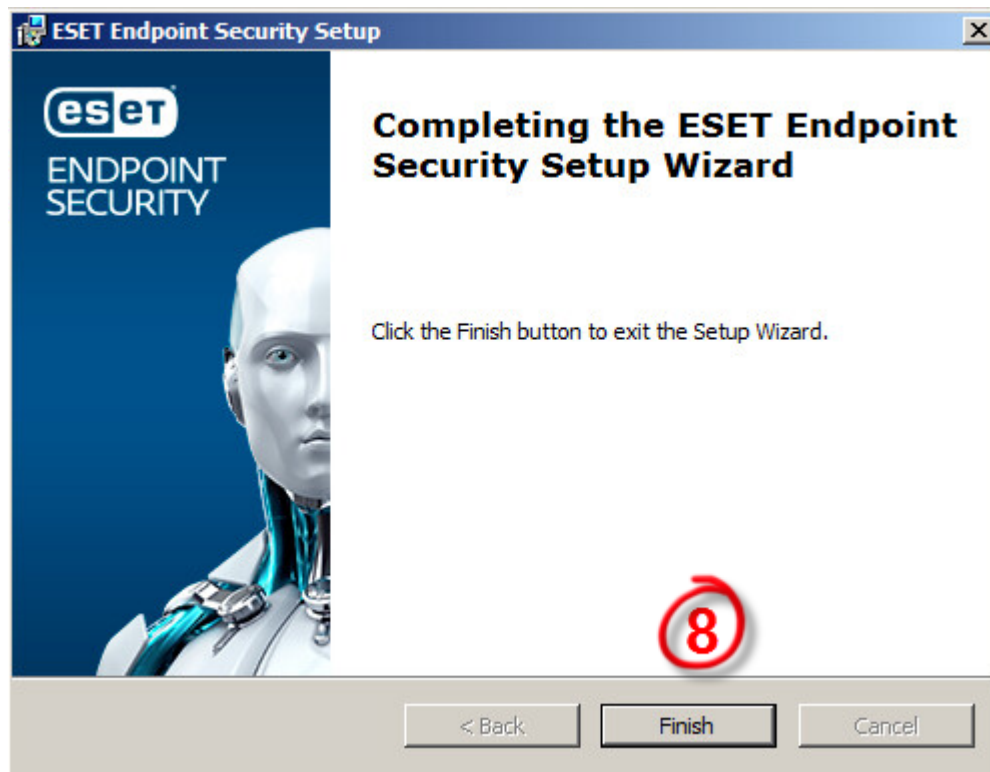
