The following table details the maximum file sizes of the various encryption features of DESlock+.

| Feature | Maximum Size |
|---|--|
| Full Disk Encryption | No limit ¹ |
| Removable Media Encryption | No limit ¹ + 4 |
| DESlock+ Go | Maximum size of 4 GB per file by Microsoft WebDAV services ³ |
| File Encryption (.dlp files) ² | Maximum size of 3.99 GB |
| Text and Clipboard Encryption | Maximum size of 3.99 GB, this may be further limited by the text container used |
| Archives (.dpk files) | Maximum size of archive 4 GB, maximum size of individual files within archive 2 GB |
| Virtual disks (.mnt, .dlpvdisk) | Maximum size of 2 TB on NTFS/exFAT drives, 4 GB on FAT32 |
| Folder Encryption | No limit ¹ |

¹ No limit imposed by DESlock+, Operating system/hardware limits still apply

² Applies to file encryption, email attachments, DESlock+ Reader and DESlock+ Mobile
