

Release announcement: ESET Endpoint Antivirus/Security 7.3.2032.0

ESET Endpoint Antivirus and ESET Endpoint Security version 7.3.2032.0 have been released and are available for download.

Change-log:

- **Important: During upgrade from older versions, an immediate reboot is required to allow real-time file-system protection to reinitialize and become fully functional.**
- Added: **Compatibility with future Windows 10 major update, due in H1 2020.**
- Added: Prevent keyboard focus stealing when any interactive application window is being displayed.
- Fixed: When special characters are used in SSID of discovered Wi-Fi networks, duplicates of the same network can occur in the list of known networks.
- Fixed: Sensitivity levels of detection mechanism would block files even if configured to report only.
- Fixed: Bootstrapped installer would abort if installation folder is not empty, regardless of forced background clean-up.
- Fixed: A finished on-demand scan initiated from central management console can result in shutting down the scanned computer even without activated shutdown option.



Restart required after upgrade from a previous version

Real-time file system protection may become non-functional.

- Managed using ESMC/ECA: When using the ESMC/ECA client task, select the check box [Automatically reboot when needed](#) to restart client workstations after the upgrade.
- Individual client workstations: Restart the computer immediately on your computer after the upgrade.

Known issues:

- HIPS component is reporting wrong status after enabling before restart.
- Policies with thousands of entries in certain configuration lists take very long, or fail to synchronize with central management console.
- On Windows 10, build version 1903 and 1909, the integration with AMSI can stop working and PowerShell scripts execution cannot be monitored on-the-fly.
- ZIP-archives with many infected objects will not be logged correctly if native Windows unpacker is used for decompression.
