Changelog version 8.1.200.0

- Fixed: Issues when ESET Inspect Connector sometimes lost its license
- Fixed: Issues when ESET Inspect license was not migrated with product update
- Fixed: Firewall is no longer enabled by default. It will be activated for customers upgrading from version 8 if they previously enabled it. Although the firewall is disabled by default, MDM setup is still required, except for upgrades from ESET Endpoint Security for macOS version 8 where the firewall was already configured or from ESET Endpoint Antivirus for macOS version 6
- Fixed: Firewall no longer blocks localhost connections for applications such as Gradle, Messenger...
- Fixed: Issues where product reported out-of-date modules even though they were the most up-to-date
- Fixed: Issues where some settings from version 7 were not properly migrated once upgraded to version 8
- Fixed: On-demand scan handler being spammed by "Interrupted system call" in event logs
- Fixed: Issues where some customers were not able to activate the product using ESET Business Account credentials (ESET HUB from now)
- Fixed: Differences between Windows and macOS Vulnerability and Patch Management logs
- Fixed: Issues where the onboarding launched after upgrade when it shouldn't
- Fixed: Shutdown of services during product upgrade

- Fixed: High memory usage when network access protection was disabled by component installation
- Fixed: Various minor issues
