I. Create a static group

1. In the ESET Remote Administrator Console (ERAC) click **Tools** → **Group Manager**.
2. Click the **Static Groups** tab and then click **Create**.

3. Enter a name for your static group (for example, "**Static Group 1**") and click **OK**.

4. Select the group you just created and click **Add/Remove**.

5. Select workstations that you want to include in your static group in the **All items** window and click > to add them to the **Selected items** window. Click **OK** to confirm your selections and then continue to part II below.

II. Apply a policy rule to your static group

1. In the ERAC click **Tools** → **Policy Manager** → **Policy Rules** tab and then click **New**.

2. Enter a name for the rule and click **Edit**.

3. Define the policy rule by selecting items in the **Rule conditions** section. In the example below, **From Primary Server** and **IS New Client** are selected. Click **OK** to confirm your selections.

4. Click **Policy Rules Wizard**. Click **Yes** if you are prompted to save changes.

5. Click **Group Manager**.

6. Select the static group you created in part I and click **OK**.

7. Click **Next**. Leave **Static groups** selected under **Group categories** and click **Next**.

8. Select whether to use a parent policy and click **Next**.

9. Click **Finish** once the progress bar fills and then click **OK** to exit Policy Manager. Your new policy rules should now be applied to the static group you defined in part I.
