1. Open ESET Remote Administrator Web Console (ERA Web Console) in your web browser and log in. [Open ERA Web Console.](#)
2. Click **Admin**  → **Policies**. Select the applicable master policy, click the gear icon and then select **Edit**.

Exclude websites on individual client workstation

1. Open the ESET Endpoint Security or ESET Endpoint Antivirus. [Open my ESET product.](#)
2. Press the **F5** key to open Advanced setup.
3. Expand **Web and Email** → **Web access protection** → **URL Address Management** and then click **Edit** next to Address list.
