**Important**: If the removable media is encrypted using the File mode of encryption then removing the encryption will **Delete** the contents of the encrypted folder permanently. Therefore you should remove data from the encrypted folder you require before removing the encryption.

## Full Disk Mode

Right click on the DESlock+ system tray icon. Select the **Removable Media\Removable Media Encryption** menu item. Select the device to remove encryption from in the list of disks. Click the **Decrypt** button.

Click **Yes** to the confirmation that you wish to decrypt the drive.

Once the operation has completed click **OK** to the completion notification.

## File Mode

Right click on the DESlock+ system tray icon. Select the **Removable Media\Removable Media Encryption** menu item. Select the device to remove encryption from in the list of disks. Click the **Decrypt** button.

Click **Yes** to the confirmation that the encrypted data will be **Deleted**.

Once the operation has completed click  $\ensuremath{\textbf{OK}}$  to the completion notification.
