If you do not use ESET Remote Administrator to manage your network

Perform these steps on individual client workstations

Transfer ESET business products between computers installed on your office network using ESET Remote Administrator (ERA)

1. Uninstall any non-ESET antivirus software installed on your new computers.

It is very important that you uninstall any antivirus software that is currently present on the machines that you are installing ESET on. After you have identified any existing antivirus product on your new computer, uninstall it using one of the uninstallers from the following Knowledgebase article:

- Uninstallers (removal tools) for common antivirus software
- If you are migrating to a new ESET Remote Administrator server, <u>migrate ESET Remote Administrator to your new server</u>. If you are migrating a 6.x ERA server, follow the instructions in <u>this Knowledgebase article</u>. If you are not migrating your ERA server, skip this step and proceed to step 3.
- 3. If you have a new license file for your ESET products, <u>remove</u>

your existing license file and replace it with the new one.

4. <u>Use ESET Remote Administrator to move client workstations to</u> <u>your new server</u>.

<u>Transfer ESET business products between</u> <u>computers (individual client workstations)</u>

 - <u>Download and install endpoint products on individual client</u> <u>workstations(5.x)</u>
 - Download and install ESET NOD32 Antivirus 4 for Linux

 - Uninstall ESET endpoint or server products
 - <u>Uninstall ESET endpoint products for macOS</u>
