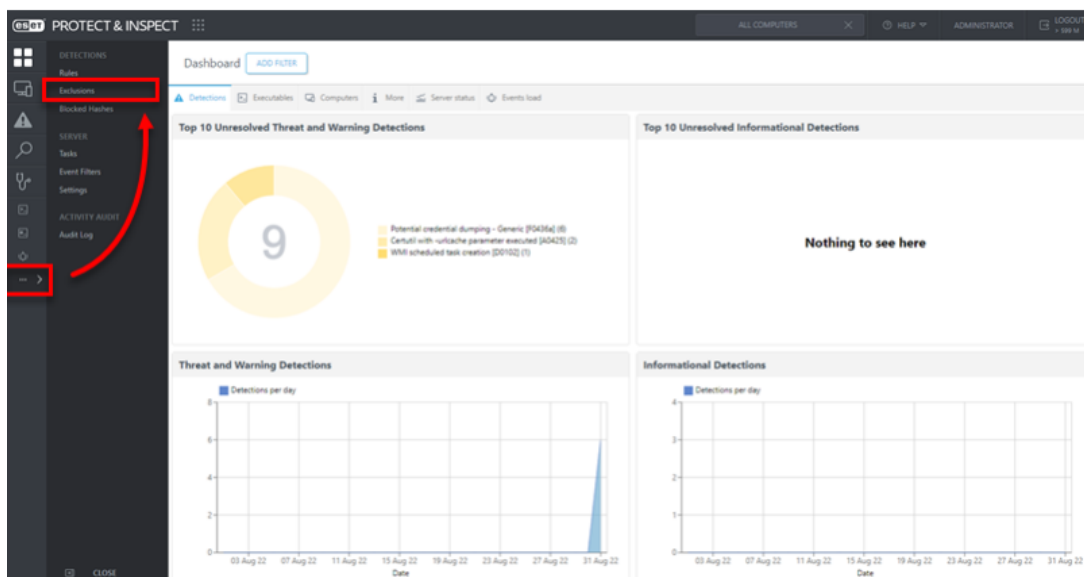

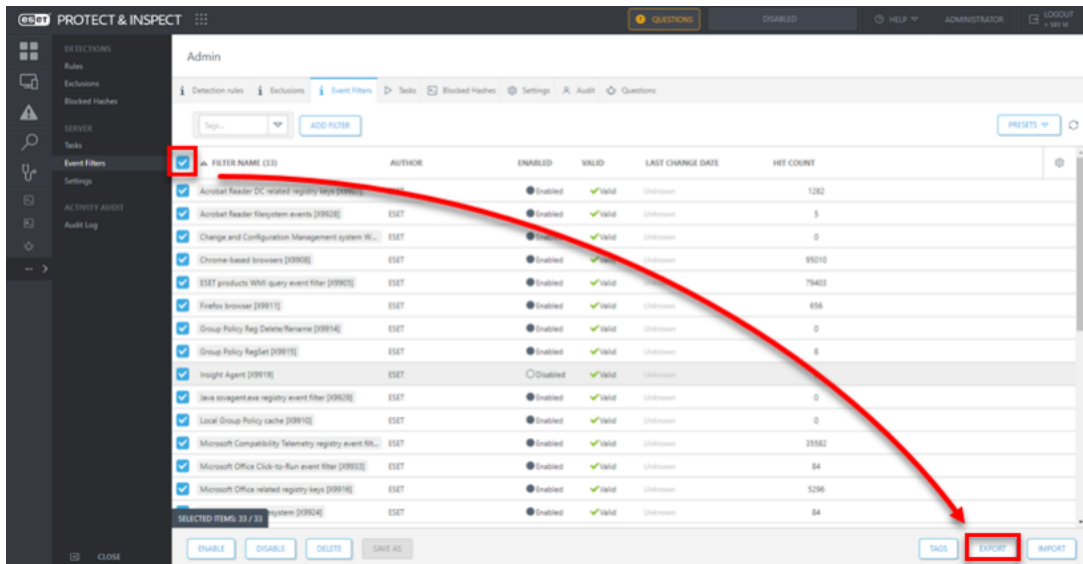
## Export event filter as backup

2. Remove all filters, select the check box next to **Name** and click **Export**.



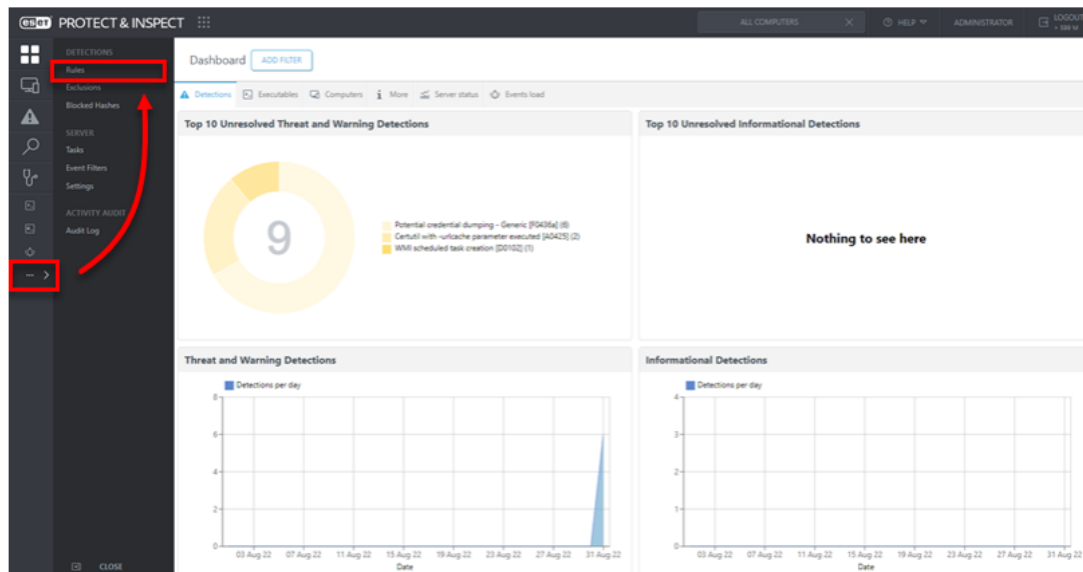
## Export Any Custom Rules



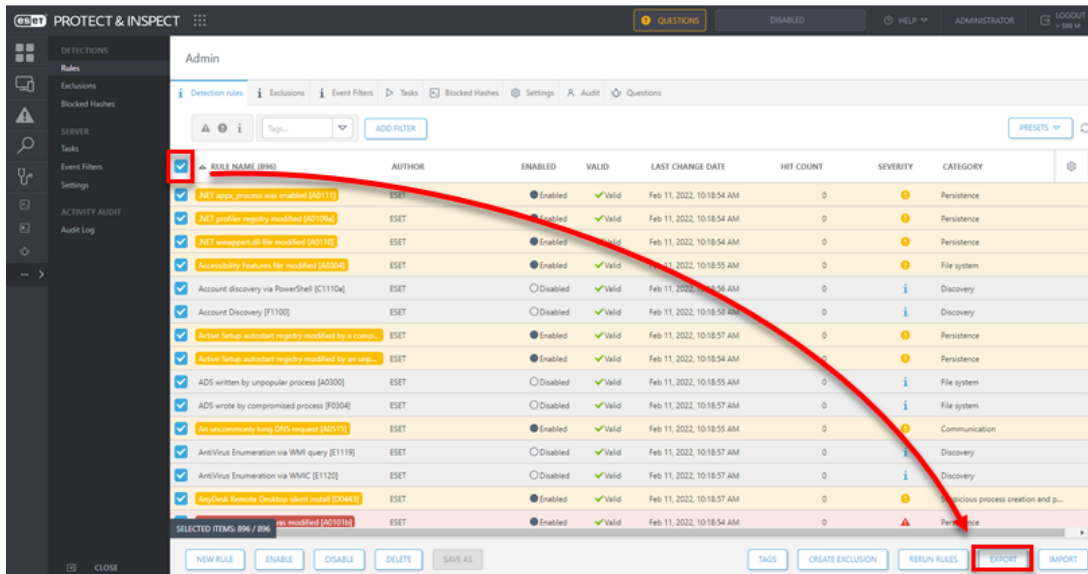
Only export custom rules

1. Click **More** → **Rules**.

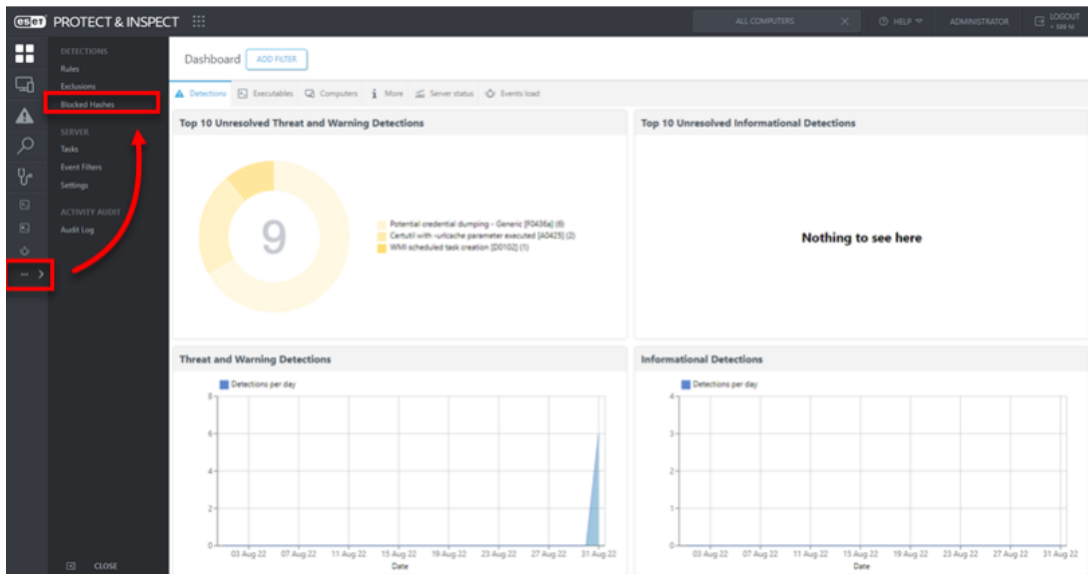


2. Filter for **Author isNot ESET**, select the check box next to **Name** and click **Export**.
