What's new (high level vs. v4.5):

Everything, but in particular:

- In-kernel on-access scanner
- Micro-services architecture
- Native 64-bit architecture
- Self-restart of daemons
- Parallel on-demand scans

- Automated deployment support (Puppet, Ansible, etc.) – silent installation
- Full LiveGrid support
- Exclusions by file or path
- Exclusions by threat or hash
- Ability to define dynamically to scan local drives, network drives or removable media
- Preserve last access timestamp during the scan
- Run background on-demand scans with low priority
- Remote file scanning using ICAP protocol

- Set of 2 different update servers
- Pre-release module update
- Delayed module updates
- Module Rollback

- Consistent settings in product and ESMC management console (use of config engine)

Known issues in release version:

- File Security for Linux is not available within "Install package on Repository" in software install task in ESMC. It's, however, possible to install using Install by direct package URL
(https://download.eset.com/com/eset/apps/business/efs/linux/v7/latest/efs.x86_64.bin). It will be solved with the release of Security Management Center 7.1
- Quarantine screen is not localized in other languages than English
- Activation with Subscription license will activate the product, however product is reporting to GUI and ESMC "License expired" and the expiration date is "-". Modules are updated properly.
- "Enable more frequent updates of detection signatures" is not working
- "Log all objects" setting does not work
