- FIXED: Inconsistent server state for Web Console and MMC for multiple ESA Core servers
- FIXED: Mounting SharePoint folders (Map Network Drive) does not work when current user has 2FA
- FIXED: iOS app layout issues
- FIXED: YubiKey HW token as keyboard - support another keyboard layouts
- FIXED: Various other bug fixes
